John McDevitt, on the California 2019 Dive-boat tragedy. Following the AGM/Conference, Committee members received, positive feedback from attendees, and the speakers. We have another planned Branch speaker series, scheduled in October 2021, open to members and non-members.

The vision and scope of holding a bi-annual speaker series, is to connect the marine surveyor and industry, to relevant and common matters, from a national to regional perspective. Building a Canadian IIMS communication base, where the marine surveyor can align themselves to learn, grow, and engage, through networking opportunities. The speaker series is one of our building blocks, in creating a value brand, sustainable revenues, and solid industry relationships.
